

### Geographical Area

To be eligible for nomination for any Active York Sports Award you must have been born in, train or compete within City of York Council's boundaries. Nominees will have achieved significant success at city, county, regional, national or international level or made a significant contribution to the city.

### Period of Qualification

Minimum of a 9-month period running between February 2018 and February 2019.

## YOUNG ACHIEVERS – U18s

### Young Sportsperson

The aim of this award is to recognise the commitment, dedication and success achieved by young sportsmen and women in York.

### Young Disabled Sportsperson

The aim of this award is to recognise the commitment, dedication and success achieved by young sportsmen and women in disability sport in York.

### Junior Team/Club Award

This award aims to recognise and celebrate outstanding success, development or significant achievement in the last 12 months for a team or club within City of York Council's boundaries.

## SENIOR ACHIEVERS – OVER 18s

### Student Sportsperson

This award aims to recognise the sporting success of an individual who has achieved when playing or volunteering in their sport. They will have enjoyed success and had impact at institutional, city, county, regional or national level. Nominees must be in higher education and studying a recognised qualification in York.

### Sportsperson

The aim of this award is to celebrate the commitment, dedication and success achieved by the best of York's sporting talent. The winner of this award will have achieved success at a regional, national or international level within the last year. Athletes from all recognised \*Δ sports aged over 18 years are eligible for this award.

### Disabled Sportsperson

The aim of this award is to celebrate the commitment, dedication and success achieved by the best of York's sporting talent. The winner of this award will have achieved success at regional, national or international level within the last year. Athletes from all recognised sports\*Δ aged over 18 years are eligible for this award.

### Team/Club Award

This award aims to recognise and celebrate outstanding success, development or significant achievement in the last 12 months for a team or club within City of York Council's boundaries.

## SPECIAL CONTRIBUTION

### Active School of the Year

This award recognises schools, groups or individuals who have made a significant contribution to school sport and physical activity in education in York. The award will recognise all involved with initiatives and events that have created a positive, healthy environment for the pupils, families and staff both inside and outside of school.

### Active in York Award

This award is aimed at rewarding workplaces, groups or individuals who may be training and taking part locally to achieve great things in their active leisure time and are inspiring others to "Get Active". This award is open age.

### Coach of the Year

This award seeks to recognise the important and inspirational role of coaches in the city, who work with sports clubs and athletes, at elite, amateur and grassroots level.

### Volunteer of the Year

This award is designed to recognise the importance of volunteers who dedicate a significant amount of time and involvement supporting physical activity and community sport within York.

### Outstanding Contribution to Sport Award

This award will be presented when a nominee is deemed deserving of this accolade and recognises an individual who has demonstrated total commitment and dedication to their sport, or sports in general, over a considerable period of time.
